The Transportation Security Administration released a series of documents announcing the test phase of an airline passenger screening system known as "Secure Flight." The program, which focuses on matching passengers against a watch list of suspected terrorists, supersedes the much-criticized CAPPS II - the Computer Assisted Passenger Pre-screening System. The new program puts an increased premium on the reliability of watch list entries.
